**Answers to your common queries / questions**

- Q. How should I fill the registration form, options / choices etc.  
Read carefully  
1) Information booklet  
2) Instructions for filling on-line registration form  
3) Notification(s)  
4) Frequently asked questions (FAQs)  
5) Seat matrix etc.  
6) Proforma for certificates, bond  
7) College information sheet etc.  
available at the website, before you start filling the registration form, on-line.
- Q. I am facing difficulty in filling the option form. What should I do?

**(Also mention your name, registration number, etc. in the mail).**
- Q. What is the last date for depositing registration fees at e-Mitra.  
Last date for depositing the fees through e-Mitra/CSC network is 20.07.2017 (5.00 pm).
- Q. What is the last date for submission of on-line registration form?  
Last date for submitting the registration form at the website is 20.07.2017 (11.45 pm)
- Q. In 10 + 2, my subjects are Physics, Chemistry and Biotechnology. Am I eligible to apply for BDS?  
No.

Q. What are the payment modes for registration fee? I am facing difficulty in making payment at e-Mitra kiosk. What should I do?

There are following payment modes for paying Registration fee

- a. Online (Debit card / Credit card / Internet banking)
- b. e-Mitra Kiosk

Select your payment mode very carefully.

Changing the payment mode is not permissible after selection.

For example, once you select on-line mode, you will have to make payment through on-line mode only and you will not be permitted to make payment through e-Mitra Kiosk.

Similarly, once you select e-Mitra kiosk, you will have to make payment through the same e-Mitra kiosk only and you will not be permitted to make payment through on-line mode.

Q. What is the distribution of seats in different medical, dental colleges?

The total number of seats (tentative seat matrix) in Government / Private Medical, Dental colleges is given in the seat matrix. The number of seats is subject to increase or decrease; and will be notified from time to time.

Q. What is the minimum requirement of NEET 2017 percentile / marks for Medical / Dental courses?

Category	Percentile in NEET 2017
GEN, OBC CL	50 percentile and above (131 marks and above)
GEN PH	45 percentile and above (118 marks and above)
OBC NCL	40 percentile and above (107 marks and above)
SC	40 percentile and above (107 marks and above)
ST	40 percentile and above (107 marks and above)
ST-STA	40 percentile and above (107 marks and above)
SC/ST/OBC PH	40 percentile and above (107 marks and above)

**In addition, you must also fulfill the percentage criteria of 10+2 class as per your category etc.**

Q. How should I fill the choices of colleges and courses, on-line?

The process of filling choices is given in the 'instructions to fill on-line registration form'. Read it very carefully before you start filling the choices of colleges, course(s), on-line.

Also refer the College Information Sheet available at the website including fees structure for different types of seats.

- Q. **What is the process of on-line allotment?**
- Registration form submission along with Choice filling
  - Process of seat allotment – round 1
  - Round 1 result publication
  - Reporting at the allotted college against 1<sup>st</sup> round

- Q. **From where I can fill the registration form and choices, on-line?**  
On-line registration and choice filling can be done from any place of convenience (including from home) using internet.

- Q. **How do I get access to the choice filling screen?**  
It is a part of registration process. You have to use your registration no. and password.

You are advised to keep the above information confidential. It is very important for participating in on-line allotment process. Sharing of this information can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of a genuine candidate from the on-line allotment process.

- Q. **What is the minimum and maximum number of choices that I can fill?**  
In order to participate in the on-line allotment process, you are required to fill minimum 1 choice. There is no restriction for filling maximum number of choices.

If you do not fill even a single choice, you will not be considered for allotment. You can fill as many choices as you wish to fill.

- Q. **I belong to SC, ST, OBC NCL category. What certificate am I required to produce at the time of reporting at allotted college?**  
You are required to submit the caste certificate issued by the competent authority. In case you fail to produce the same at allotted Medical / Dental College then you will not be permitted to join the allotted college and your category will be treated as General for the subsequent allotment round(s) (only on the seats remaining vacant after the first round), if otherwise eligible. You will be responsible for such allotment.

- Q. **If in round 1, I do not get my higher preference choice, then, is there any possibility of getting a higher preference choice.**  
Yes. You may be considered for 2<sup>nd</sup> round (upward movement) for your higher preference choice.

For this, you are required to join allotted college and complete the admission formalities then only you can exercise option to participate in next round.

- Q. **What is 2<sup>nd</sup> round of allotment process?**  
Second round of allotment process is off-line round, against the seats remaining vacant due to non-reporting / non-joining by a candidate at the allotted college.

Q. Who is eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> round of allotment?

Candidates eligible for seat allotment in 2<sup>nd</sup> round would be as below:

Candidates who filled their choice(s) and did not get any seat allotment in the 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Candidates, who were allotted a seat against reserved/PH category in 1<sup>st</sup> round and their 1<sup>st</sup> round was cancelled during the document verification on reporting for admission as they could not produce caste certificate / PH certificate, but would still be eligible for the next round of seat allotment, with changed criteria (i.e. from reserved/ PH to unreserved).

Candidates who reported at the allotted college after 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Q. Who is not eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> round of allotment?

Not reported at allotted college after seat allotment in 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Reported & withdrawn from counseling at allotted college.

Became non-eligible due to change of eligibility criteria during document verification.

Q. If I have already been admitted in MBBS course and have deposited my documents in that medical college and come for on-line/ off-line counseling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "original certificates are deposited with the medical college", will I be allowed to join the college allotted to me State UG 2017 counseling?.

A candidate without **Original certificates / documents** shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in MBBS course and has deposited his / her certificates in any medical college / institute / university and comes for on-line/ off-line counseling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the medical college / institute / university" (except the college allotted through Rajasthan State UG 2017), will **NOT** be allowed to take admission at the allotted college.
